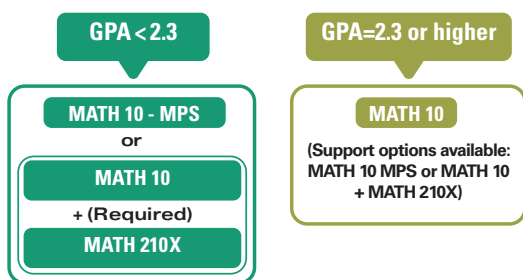

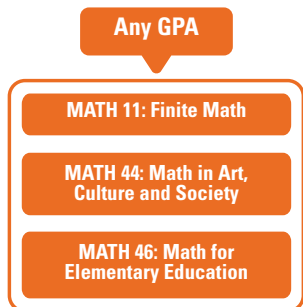
Humanities and Liberal Arts Majors: Choose from these options based on your goals and high school GPA

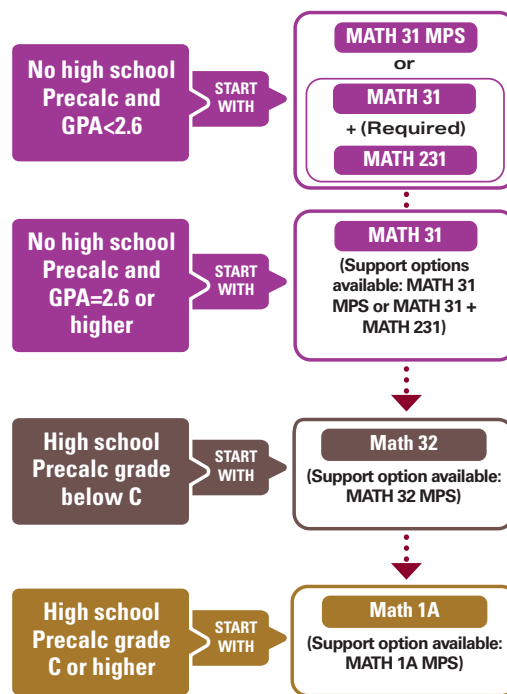

Notes:

- All students have the option of taking the Math Guided Self-Placement to see if they can begin at a higher level than indicated here.
- Students who have placed in a transfer-level course (MATH 10, 11, 44, 46 or MATH 31 and higher) can register for any course that has a prerequisite of intermediate algebra or other developmental math.
- Students who have placed in MATH 32 or higher can register for MATH 12 and other courses that have a prerequisite of MATH 31.
