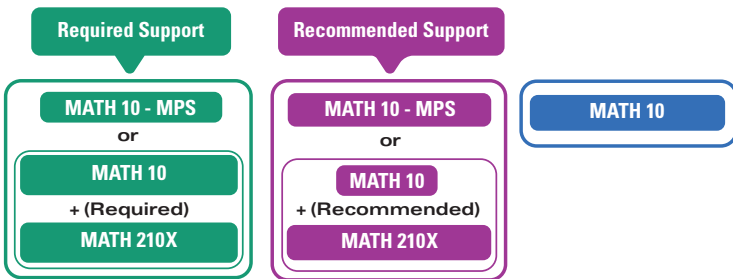

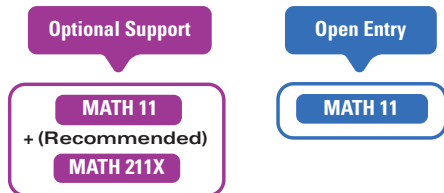
Humanities and Liberal Arts Majors: Four options, depending on academic goals and Guided Self-Placement results

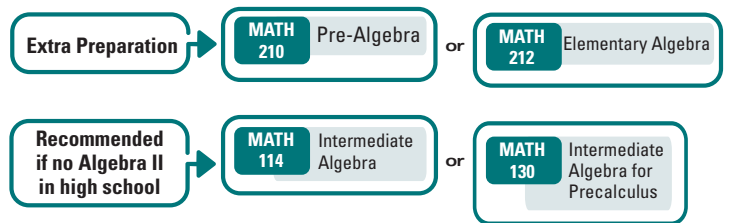

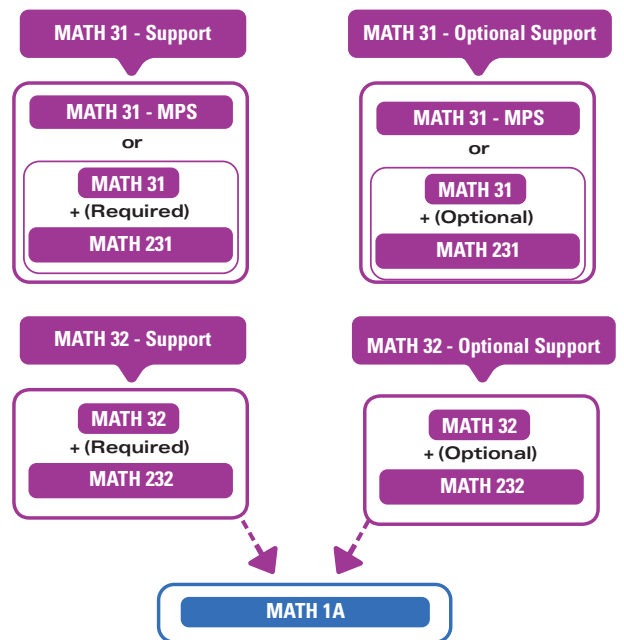
